Wk 1 - YES - Game Sheet

Help kids locate the things that are wrong with the picture. As they find what's wrong, read the corresponding situation and questions.



*If your cousin wants to climb a coconut tree that your family told you to stay away from, should you help your cousin obey or sneak and climb the tree with him? (Help him obey) Sometimes our families are going to do wrong things because no family is perfect. But you can help your family obey because that's what is best for them.*



*Let's say you get to go to art camp this summer, but your cousin doesn't get to go to any camps, and she feels sad about it. Will bragging about how great art camp is hurt your relationship with your cousin? (Yes) Bragging is not what God wants us to do, and when we disobey Him, it hurts our families.*



*Would it make you jealous if your mom put away all of your brother's laundry but made you put yours away yourself? (Allow responses) Sometimes we may feel jealous of our family. But we don't need to be like Cain and do something to get back at someone because that will only hurt ourselves and our families.*



*If your sister borrows your hat and lets the dog chew on it, how would you feel? (Allow responses) Even if you are mad at your sister for doing that, should you stop letting her borrow things? (No) Instead, you can obey God and forgive your sister. Then you can help your sister know how to do what's right next time.*

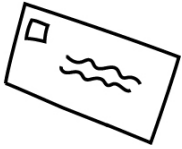


*Let's say there's only one special cup left in the cabinet and you and your cousin both want to drink out of it. If you two argue over it, do you think that will help your family? (No) God tells us to do everything without arguing or complaining because He knows that it will hurt our relationships and isn't what's best for our families.*

***Your parents told you not to get any ice cream without asking first. One day, you sneak to grab a spoon, eat some, and then lie about it when they ask. Did you obey? (No) We all disobey sometimes because we're not perfect. But do you think it would have been better to tell the truth? (Yes) God wants us to always tell the truth to our families!***



***One day, you're walking to your mailbox when you hear your neighbors yelling at each other. You thought their family was perfect because their house is nice and they always wave at you. But is their family perfect? (No) Is your family perfect? (No) No family is perfect because we all can disobey God, but thankfully, He loves us anyway!***



***Your mom says it's time to stop playing and do your homework. You are having so much fun and you're not ready to stop. Should you stomp and scream or stop playing and obey? (Stop playing and obey) Nobody in our family is perfect, including us. Sometimes we'll want to do wrong things when we don't get our way, but the right thing to do is obey!***



***Your little brother hates to put on sunscreen. He throws a fit every time he has to put it on, and that makes you feel frustrated. When you're frustrated, should you yell at him or show him love? (Show him love) Yes! Even when we're frustrated, we can show love to others by remembering no one in our family is perfect.***
