

STAY TOGETHER SHEET

Directions: Do any of the following activities to keep your small group engaged until all kids have been checked out.

- **Get to Know Your Group** - Ask kids any of the following questions:
 - *Where is your favorite place to go on vacation?*
 - *Who are the people that live in your house?*
 - *What is your favorite thing to do or play?*
 - *Would you rather go swimming with dolphins or whale watching?*
 - *Would you rather collect seashells or sharks' teeth?*
 - *If you could create a new flavor of shave ice, what flavor would you make?*
- **Play "Pictionary"** - Use the **dry erase marker** to draw pictures on the **dry erase board** for kids to guess. Use the **paper towels** to erase and play again!
 - The leader should be the only person drawing.
 - Kids can take turns telling the leader what to draw for the group to guess.
- **Play "I Spy"** - Have kids take turns "spying" an object in the room, and allow the other kids to guess what the object is.
- **Spinner** - Have kids take turns spinning the **spinner** and choose to do any of the following based on the number the spinner lands on:
 - Have kids do that many of a particular motion, such as: clapping, hopping, seconds to run in place, number of jumping jacks, etc.
 - Have kids tell that many of his/her favorite things, such as: foods, games, TV shows, animals, colors, sports, athletes, books, movies, etc.
 - Select that many kids to say the Need to Know or memory verse together.
 - Come up with that many items that begin with a certain letter or fit a specific category, such as island things, sea animals, colors, sports, etc.
- **Play "Lifeguard Says"** - Have kids stand up. Say motions for kids to do, saying, "Lifeguard says," before most of the motions. Have kids sit down if they do something that the "Lifeguard" did not say to do. Continue playing until one child remains standing or as time allows.
 - For younger groups, say "Lifeguard says," before every action.
 - For older groups, play multiple rounds, allowing different kids to be the "Lifeguard."
